

Cash Me Out scores Victory at Saratoga

Cash Me Out ([Cash Hall](#)) scored his third victory of the year in the local Open Trot on Sunday (July 12) afternoon at Saratoga Casino Hotel. Jimmy Devaux piloted the Kyle Spagnola-trained trotter and moved him first over approaching the half. Cash Me Out hit his best gear and cruised past his rivals to open up a big lead heading towards three-quarters. The 5-year-old highstepper was met with challenges in the stretch

from Boli (Wally Hennessey) and Stirling Cadet (Frank Coppola Jr) but held them both off before stopping the timer in 1:54.4. The victory was number eight on the year for Cash Me Out who is just shy of \$110,000 in earnings midway through July. Boli was the runner up for the third consecutive start in the \$15,000 Open while Stirling Cadet finished third to hit the board for the six straight time in the Sunday feature. Cash Me Out was the race's 3-2 betting favorite and led an exacta and triple that returned \$34.20 and \$237.50, respectively. Live racing resumes on Thursday (July 14) with first post time set for 4:00 p.m.
